

**I AM MY NEIGHBOR'S KEEPER**  
**Twelve Tips for #TEAMOLNEYVILLE**



1. Get to know your neighbors. See your neighbors and let them see you. Make an effort to wave and say hello. Get to know neighbors by name. Share and do random acts of kindness.
2. Treat all residents and business owners with courtesy and respect. Avoid judgement and respect others values, cultures and opinions.
3. Invest in the Olneyville community. When possible, shop at stores in the neighborhood.
4. Make good use of the 3 Olneyville neighborhood parks; Donigian, Riverside and Joslin Community Park.
5. Participate in neighborhood events and programs and encourage other residents to do so as well.
6. Stay informed on community issues and vote.
7. Follow rules for pedestrian safety (cross at corners and crosswalks, use sidewalks when available, etc).
8. Observe all vehicle safety and driving laws including; stopping at stop signs, allowing pedestrians to cross, driving the speed limit, not entering the wrong way on one way streets, and parking only where parking is permitted.
9. Help keep the neighborhood clean. Be sure to recycle, after trash pickup, remove trash receptacles from sidewalks in a timely manner. Do no litter and no dumping in vacant lots, sidewalks and parks.
10. Be prideful of your home whether you rent or own! Keep sidewalks clean and free of trash and litter. Keep lawn maintained when possible and remove snow in a timely manner. Help another neighbor in need of snow removal or lawn maintenance.
11. Keep noise levels at a reasonable level, especially during early morning and evening hours.
12. If your home has a dog, adhere to all leash and immunization laws. Be aware of excessive barking and be sure to clean up after your pet!
